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WHAT HAS BEEN DONE?



We have successfully organised **the final Intergenerational Green Future event "ACT! The Green Future of My City and Country"** that took place in Vilnius on June 3rd. This was a three-part civic action where Vilniaus Karoliniškių gymnasium society, representatives of the steering group, project partner organisations, and the general public joined together to:

- 1) Create a collage on the topic of Green Future and sustainability
- 2) Make interviews with passers-by on the streets
- 3) Take part in a photo exhibition and grow a Green Future tree

This event was an opportunity for different generations to engage in creative conversation on sustainable practices. We are proud to present the results!



Since the beginning of the project, more than 300 people have participated in intergenerational dialogues. During the final event atleast 80 students and teachers joind the activities. We are convinced that the impact will continue to reach many more.

During the civic action defined with the Green Future of My City and Country"...

Participants created a **joined collage** on the topic of green future and green mindset. While making the collage, students could start an informal conversation and exchange their thoughts with their teachers and project partners on this



particular topic.





During the event, Karoliniškių gymnasium society participated in **growing a Green Future tree** by leaving their wishes on sticky notes, in this way encouraging others to take care of sustainability and a green future. Project partners were involved in this activity by inviting students and teachers to grow the Green Future tree together.





A photo exhibition on the topic of the Green Deal was prepared by project partners, gymnasium students, and teachers. This was an interactive exhibition where event participants discussed what was captured in the photos.







One of the goals of the event was to educate students and members of society about the European Green **Deal.** During the street interviews, students together with project managers asked passers-by whether they had heard about the Green Deal and what they do/ have done for sustainability. The answers indicated that many are engaged in different sustainability practices such as sorting trash or seeking to reduce waste. Interviews were also an opportunity to explain to society more about the European Green Deal and how everyone can contribute.

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Overall impressions about the final Green Future event in Vilnius were positive. Both students and project partners agreed that the event was relevant to the topic and very engaging. Since the participants were asked to express themselves visually, it created space for fruitful discussions and interactions between representatives from different generations. Thanks to this civic action, there is now increased awareness about sustainable practices as well as interest to personally be involved in green activities.
