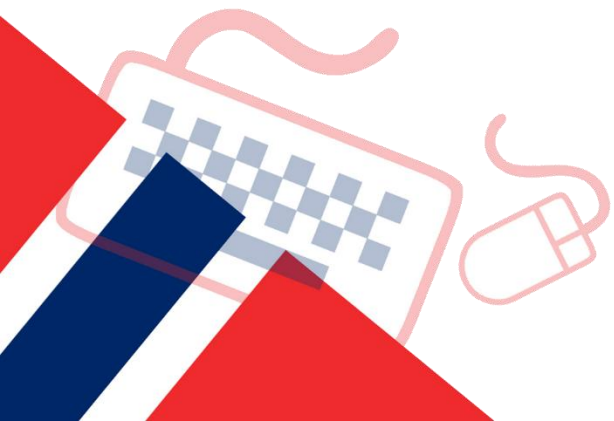

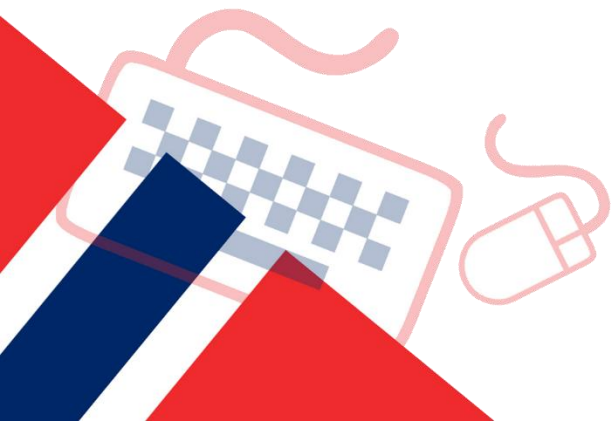
Benefits of bringing technology into the classroom:

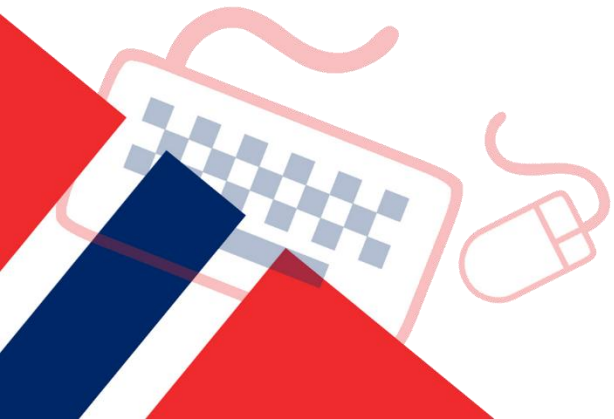

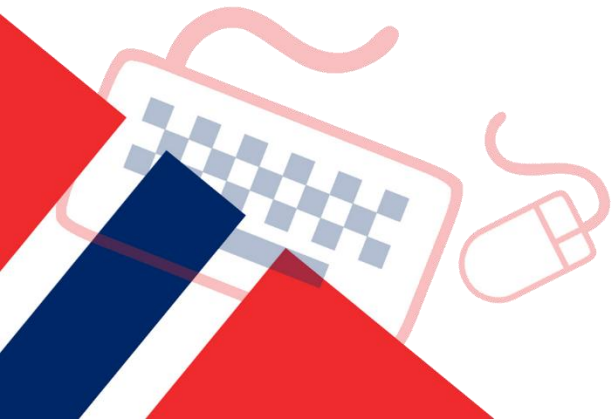
How does modern technology affect education?

Do you agree? What could be done by educators in order to include technology more in the teaching-learning process?

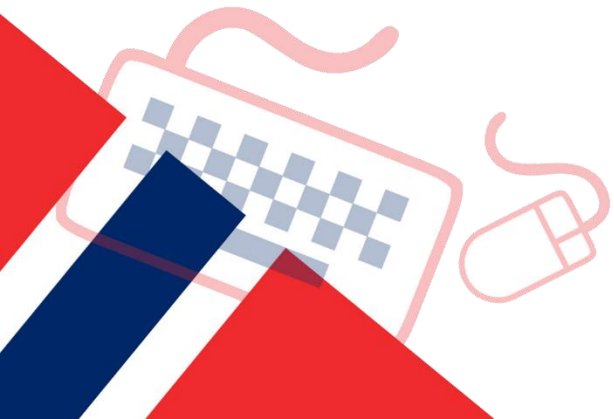


What external and internal barriers do teachers have to overcome in order to embrace technology in their classroom?
